Since the inception of the Germination Project, our Fellows have, among a host of other activities, visited the New York Stock Exchange, conferred with cutting edge artists, curators and historians at Christie's and Sotheby's, undertaken groundbreaking lab research with neurologists and Jefferson University, collaborated with the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School of Business and Social Impact Initiative, and co-organized pop-up health clinics with the American Heart Association in Philadelphia's underserved neighborhoods.

Our Fellows, as part of their development, will focus on eradicating intergenerational poverty in our region.
