
PHILADELPHIA CAN ONCE AGAIN BECOME THE WORKSHOP OF THE WORLD.

CULTIVATE THE NEXT GENERATION OF LEADERS.



Connect the current generation of leaders with the next to build a cross-generational, sustainable network of thinkers, visionaries and achievers.



Retain the next generation of leaders so that they can use their gifts to grow and strengthen our great city.

BUILDING THE ECOSYSTEM.

Just as no young athletic standout can rely on a single motivational speech or a one-off expert training session to launch his or her career, the Germination Project recognizes that the investment of this generation's leaders in the futures of the next generation must be a long term investment.

STEP 1

THE SUMMER LEADERSHIP BOOT CAMP

First, each annual Germination Project Student
Leadership Class will convene with an intensive, twoweek summer boot camp for rising high school juniors.
The program, initially funded by a grant from the
Pamela and Ajay Raju Foundation, will be hosted by
the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania.
The curriculum will delve into a series of core
leadership concepts through in-person instruction by
hand-picked faculty, case studies and collaborative
projects.

STEP 2

ENLIST THE REGION'S CURRENT LEADERS

Germination Project Fellows will be matched with mentors at the commencement of Boot Camp. These mentors will be drawn from a pool of the region's top young professionals in the early to middle phases of their careers, who are well equipped to recognize and respond to the particular challenges faced by the post-millennial generation.

Fellows will be expected to maintain contact with their mentors throughout their junior and senior years of high school. Likewise, mentors will be expected to remain involved with their Fellows. Mentors will provide guidance with the college application process, impart their wisdom and offer their support to those poised to succeed in the years to come.

STEP 3

BUILD PROFESSIONAL RELATIONSHIPS

In the months ahead, the Germination Project will facilitate networking events and creative sessions to provide alumni of the program opportunities to reconnect and work with the Fellows. Within these conversations, Mentors and Fellows will share experiences and insights about the college application process and begin to find ways that their relationship can support the Fellow's personal journey.

STEP 4

GIVE BACK

The Germination Project requires Fellows to provide community service through participation in one or more of the ongoing Germination Project Initiatives: Healthcare Access, Literacy, Financial Literacy, Urban Agriculture and other community based initiatives and volunteer experiences.

STEP 5

PAY IT FORWARD

For its Fellows, the Germination Project is not only an incubator designed to cultivate the city's next best leaders, it also solidifies a promise by its students to pay those opportunities forward by basing their future career endeavors in the city of Philadelphia.

PROM ROYALTY \$100,000

Prom Royalty sponsors will play a premier role in the Gala, VIP Cocktail Reception and will be recognized at all Germination Project events and activities throughout the year. Prom Royalty sponsors will be given the opportunity to nominate a speaker and/or prepare a video presentation to be featured on the night of the Gala, on the Germination Project's website and on all social media channels.
